REGISTRATION FOR TEVET EXAMINATIONS FOR JULY 2024 SERIES

Management of Technical and Vocational Training Institutions are hereby notified that registration for TEVET examinations for the July 2024 series is now open and shall close on 17th May 2024.

Colleges are advised to consolidate Registration Forms, compile lists of candidates per trade and per level and submit these together with examination fees to Mzuzu or Lilongwe or Blantyre Trade Testing Centre depending on the region of operation by close of business on 17th May 2024. Payment of examination fees beyond this date shall not be allowed. Colleges which are not registered by the TEVET Authority (TEVETA) or those with expired registration certificates are not allowed to participate in these examinations. So too, colleges are not allowed to register candidates in trades which are not accredited by the TEVET Authority.

Examination fees for Levels 1, 2, 3, and 4 are K20, 000.00, K30, 000.00, K40, 000.00 and K50, 000.00 per candidate respectively and this is non-refundable. Candidates are not allowed to pay examination fees on individual basis but only through their respective colleges.

Additionally, candidates are not allowed to pay for higher level examinations before attaining the lower level qualification. Repeaters must retake the failed papers only.

Colleges are further reminded to ensure that the External Verification (EV) of continuous assessments is undertaken for all eligible candidates before the commencement of summative examinations scheduled from 1st to 19th July 2024.
